- Sanction:** This meet is sanctioned by Michigan Swimming, Inc., as a timed final meet on behalf of USA Swimming, Sanction Number MI0708049. Michigan Swimming rules, safety, and warm up procedures will govern the meet as if fully set forth in these meet rules.
- Location:** Eastern Michigan University Natatorium (Olds-Robb Student Recreation Center located on the campus of Eastern Michigan University, Ypsilanti, MI 48197. Map to Pool on:

- Times:** Friday PM: Warm-up Starts: **4:30 p.m.** Events begin **5:30 p.m.**
Saturday/Sunday AM Warm-up Starts: **7:30 a.m.** Events begin: **8:30 a.m.**
Saturday/Sunday PM Warm-up Starts: **12:30 p.m.** Events begin: **1:30 p.m.**
- Facilities:** The Michael Jones pool, in the Olds-Robb Student Recreation Center is a 10-lane 50-meter pool. Depth at start is 12 feet deep and 4 feet at the turn. Permanent starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. Daktronics timing and scoreboard will be used with a 10-lane display. There is ample balcony seating for spectators. Lockers are available (provide your own lock). Public phones will be available. Eastern Michigan University, Michigan Swimming, Inc., and Club Wolverine are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Eligibility:** *Summerfest* is an **ABC meet for ALL swimmers**. Swimmers who have not swum an event may enter at "No Time" (n/t). All swimmers must be currently registered either with United States Swimming (USA) or the governing body for their club if based in a foreign country. A swimmer's age on May 30, 2008 will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group.
- Meet Format:** This is an ABC meet with 5 sessions, all timed finals format. The 10 & Under and 11 & 12 boys and girls swim in the AM sessions while the 13-14 boys & girls and Open boys and girls will swim in the PM sessions.
- Entry Limits:** Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis until the Michigan Swimming four (4) hour per session maximum time limit is met. Entries are not deemed valid and will not be processed until such time as the entry chairperson has received, in addition to the actual entry: (a) your club's signed release/waiver agreement, (b) your club's signed certification of entered athletes form and (c) your club's entry fees. Entries received after the four (4) hour per session time limit has been exceeded will be returned even if they are received before the entry deadline date. To balance sessions and/or to comply with the four (4) hour per session time limit, the Meet Referee and Meet Director reserve the right to apply any reasonable technique to reduce the session timeline including but not limited to splitting age groups, splitting teams, and amending/adding sessions. If the Meet Referee and

Meet Director desire to either split age groups and/or split teams, the specified contact person of each club entering the meet shall be provided with electronic notification of such change at least ten (10) days prior the date of the meet. A club may withdraw entries based on this change and will receive a refund of any entry fees.

The Meet Host reserves the right to limit the number of heats of any Friday night event to balance events and/or maintain 4 hour session limit.

Individual Entry

Limits: An individual may enter up to 2 events Friday and 4 individual events on Saturday and Sunday.

Electronic Entries: \$4.00 per individual event. Deck entries are \$7.00. Please include a \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered. Make checks payable to: **Club Wolverine Swimming.**

Paper Entries: Michigan Swimming's rules regarding non-electronic entries apply. \$5.00 per individual event. There is a \$1.00 additional charge per swimmer per event paid to **Club Wolverine Swimming.** The Michigan Swimming \$1.00 surcharge for each swimmer will apply. Paper entries may be submitted to the entry chair on a spreadsheet of your choice however the paper entry must be logically formatted and must contain all pertinent information to allow the entry chair to easily enter the swimmer(s) in the correct events with correct seed times.

Deck Entry: Deck entries may be accepted at the Clerk of the Course and may swim if time and space permit in the sole discretion of the Meet Referee and Meet Director(s). Deck entries are \$7 for an individual event. Deck entries are subject to MS surcharge if not already entered in the meet.

Time Trials: There will be no time trials.

Entry

Procedures: Entries may be submitted as soon as this meet announcement is posted on the MS website. All entries, whether they are by mail or email, must be received no later than Tuesday, May 20, 2008, 11:59 PM. No fax or telephone entries accepted. Entries must include the correct swimmer name (official registered names must be used), age and USA number. You can import the order of events and event numbers from the Michigan Swimming website (www.uss-michigan.com.) Entries should be emailed in Hy-Tek format. Any entries submitted will not be considered as officially received until such time as the entry chairperson has received: (a) your entry (b) the signed release/waiver agreement (c) the certification of entered athletes form (d) the relay swimmers only form (if applicable) & (e) and a team check.

Refunds: Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the entry chair there are no refunds in full or in part.

ENTRIES ARE BEING RECEIVED AT A POST OFFICE BOX. IF SENDING EXPEDITED, USE ONLY US POSTAL SERVICES. (NO FEDEX, UPS, ETC.) DELIVER WITH "NO SIGNATURE REQUIRED."

Check In: Check In will be available as of 4:15 PM Friday, 7:00 AM and 12 PM respectively Saturday and Sunday and close 15 minutes after the start of warm-ups. Check in is mandatory for all events and is required by the time set forth in this meet announcement. Failure to check in will cause the swimmer to be scratched from **all** events in that session. PLEASE FOLLOW THE POSTED CHECK IN PROCEDURE AND MICHIGAN SWIMMING CHECK IN RULES. Also note that pursuant to MS Rules that failing to swim an event after checking in for that event will disqualify a swimmer from his or her next event. Check in sheets will be posted outside the locker rooms.

Scratch Rules: Prior to check in close, a swimmer may scratch events at the Clerk of Course. After check in closes, you must see the Meet Referee to scratch an event. Once a swimmer has checked in for an event that swimmer must compete in that event or the swimmer will be scratched from his/her next event.

Swimming Safety & Warm-up

Procedure: To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers will be required to enter the pool feet first only, no jumping or diving except as detailed below. The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool.

Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the meet referee which may include ejection from the meet.

Controlled, supervised warm-up sessions will be utilized in accordance with the "warm-up procedure guidelines" suggested by USA Swimming.

The final 20 minutes of warm-ups will be conducted as follows:

- Lanes 5 & 6 push/pace with push off from the start end of the pool, or general warm-up lanes at the discretion of the Meet Referee.
- Lanes 2, 3, 8 & 9 racing start lanes. Sprint lanes for racing starts from the blocks or backstroke starts. One length only and exiting the pool.
- Lanes 1, 4, 7, 10 general warm-up, no diving or racing starts. Any one, or all of these lanes, may be converted to sprint lanes at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

Marshaling: All age groups will be **self-marshaled**. Heat cards will not be used. Heat sheets for all events will be posted in the pool area. Swimmers are responsible for reporting to the area behind the starting blocks a few heats prior to their event. If

a swimmer does not show-up for the correct heat of the event, that swimmer will be scratched for his/her next scheduled event.

Seeding: All events are timed finals and will be seeded slowest to fastest other than distance events (400, 800, and 1500 Free, and 400IM) will be seeded fastest to slowest (800/1500 Free will alternate genders).

**Changing
Events**

(Scratch/Add):

At the discretion of the Meet Director, swimmers already in the meet may be allowed to scratch an existing event and deck enter a new event (both events must be in the same session). If available, event changing must be completed no later than 15 minutes prior to check in close. The fee for changing events is the deck entry fee of \$7. Event changes are made at Clerk of Course.

Admissions: \$4 per person over the age of 16. \$2 per person for all individuals between the ages of 12 and 16. All individuals under the age of 12 are free. Meet program is \$6.

Scoring: No individual or team scoring will be kept.

Awards: **Awards will be given only for events for 12& under. No awards will be given for 13 & Over and Open events.** Ribbons will be awarded for all divisions (A, B, C) 1st – 8th places. Awards will not be distributed to swimmers; all awards will be given to coaches at the end of the Sunday session. Unattached swimmers may pick up their awards on Sunday at the awards table.

Results: Complete meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at www.uss.michigan.com. Additional copies of the results can be ordered at the admissions table for \$8. Coaches providing a memory stick may obtain results at conclusion of the meet.

**Lost and
Found:**

Articles may be turned in/picked up at the admissions table. Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained in the home of the Meet Director for 14 days (any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director).

Deck Personnel: Only swimmers, registered coaches and meet officials/workers are allowed on the deck. Coaches and officials must display their registration cards at all times. Coaches must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet.

**Swimmers with
Disabilities:**

All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups.

Info: Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the meet Referees and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting.

First Aid: Supplies will be kept at the announcer's table or in the first-aid station.

Facility Items:

- (A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of Olds-Robb Student Recreation Center.
- (B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.
- (C) **No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area.** Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions.
- (D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at the main desk of the Olds-Robb Student Recreation Center.
